### VOCABULARY

**Apostate:** A person who renounces a religious belief.

**Dispensational Theology:** Pre-tribulation rapture doctrine, end of times. Introduced in the 19<sup>th</sup> century by John Nelson Darby. (Ligonier.org)

**Dominion theology:** urges Christians to take positions of authority throughout the world to convert world into Christianity and wait for Jesus' return. (carm.org)

**Exegesis:** Explanation of biblical text through careful, objective analysis. (gotquestions.org)

**Eschatology:** Theology concerned with the end of the world.

**Harlot:** A prostitute or one who forsakes the true God and worships idols.

**Heretic:** a person who differs in opinion from established religious dogma.

**Inductive Bible Study:** Inductive Bible Study is a method of studying Scripture that seeks to find meaning in the original context and apply it to everyday life today.

**Josephus:** 37-100 A.D. Jewish historian

**Pharisees:** Members of ancient Jewish religious sect that held to strict observance of the traditional and written law.

**Rapture:** the final assumption of Christians into Heaven.

**Revelation:** Something that is revealed by God to humans, enlightenment

**Sadducees:** the wealthy class of Jewish priesthood, their lives were focused on the Temple.

**Synagogue:** A house of worship for a Jewish congregation.

**Tabernacle:** Where God lived among His people

**Torah:** The whole body of Jewish Scriptures.
